



Perimeter Security Readiness Assessment

Purpose: This tool is designed to evaluate the effectiveness of a facility's perimeter controls, including fencing, lighting, signage, gates, surveillance coverage, and enforcement presence.

It helps identify weak points in external defense layers before a threat reaches critical interior assets.

- Fence integrity and damage
- Gaps or blind spots in surveillance
- Lighting coverage and failures
- Gate lock function and badge access
- Signage clarity and placement
- Patrol frequency and coverage

Score	Rating	Interpretation	Recommended Action
5	Exceptional	No issues noted, strong perimeter deterrent posture	Maintain routine checks and use as performance model
4	Strong	Minor issues not impacting deterrence	Log and correct. Repeat in 30 days.
3	Adequate	Moderate issues may aid access	Repair or reinforce. Re-inspect in 14 days.
2	At Risk	Significant gaps that could be exploited	Immediate remediation. Repeat audit in 7 days. Reach out to Averitas for consultation.
1	Critical Gap	Breach likely to occur due to identified vulnerability	Engage Averitas for full readiness audit immediately.

5. Averitas Readiness Index

Total Score	Status	Interpretation	Action Recommendation
30-35	Operationally Ready	Strong perimeter enforcement and visibility	Continue monthly perimeter checks
24-29	Moderate Risk	Gaps are minor but notable	Address and re-check in 2 weeks
18-23	High Risk	Several zones need repair or enforcement	Reinforce and re-inspect urgently, reach out to Averitas for a consultation.
7-17	Critical Breakdown	Systems not functioning, deterrence failing	Full audit by Averitas recommended immediately
